Parent reflective functioning in mothers who were exposed to intimate partner violence. Findings from a Czech clinical sample.

Method

The present study included 25 Czech mothers who were participating in psychological assessment and therapy in the Child Centre in Faculty Thomayer Hospital in Prague. This study is a part of the international Czech-Norwegian project (identification of traumatized children and stopping domestic violence, project number ZD-ZDOVA1-001). We focused on maternal parenting quality and adverse experiences. Mothers were interviewed with the revised Parent Development Interview (PDI-R2, Slade, 2003), which was designed to assess parental reflective functioning (RF). Protocols were audio taped, transcribed and scored on 11-point scale by experienced and qualified scorers. Participants were also screened by Adverse Childhood Experience (ACE) Questionnaire which refers to some of the most frequently occurring sources of stress that they may suffer early in life. We focused on physical abuse, emotional abuse, emotional neglect, sexual abuse and witnessed domestic violence. Inclusion criteria were Czech ethnicity and enrollment in a regular therapeutic process. Exclusion criteria were severe chronic mental or physical illness. All of the mothers experienced intimate partner violence (IPV) in their previous or current relationships and some of them were also violent towards their children. Some mothers abused drugs, alcohol or both, all their children witnessed IPV. Based on literature we expected to find low RF and high prevalence of trauma in our sample.

Data analysis

We examined all variables, computed means, standard deviations and range on all measures. We scored the presence of specific traumatic experiences (childhood emotional neglect, childhood physical abuse, childhood sexual abuse and domestic violence) and reported them in percentages. We conducted Spearman's rank-order correlations accepting a significance threshold of 0.05. Correlation were calculated between study variables and different childhood traumas in ACE.

Results

Our findings confirm results in previous research on women exposed to IPV and quality of parenting. The women of our sample show poor and shallow parental RF and they perform high level of relational trauma experiences. Drug/alcohol use was elevated in this group. Contrary to our expectations neither alcohol nor drug use significantly correlated with parental RF but the education did.
